Silverwoods Bygones Sale features props from 'Victorian Farm'

Silverwoods' popular Rural Bygones sale this Saturday (17th January) showcases some TV 'stars'. A number of lots have been featured in the BBC 2 TV documentary 'The Victorian Farm', currently being aired on Thursday evenings. The programme follows a team of historians who live the life of Victorian farmers for a year and some of the authentic props from the series are being offered for sale by a local bygones enthusiast and collector.

These include a metal cinder sieve and ash receiver, a tin travelling trunk with its original paint finish, a bee smoker, a slop bucket and porcelain po, cooking pans, buckets, carpet beaters and a pine and tin galvanised washboard, scrubbing brush and wash tub.

The owner said: "A researcher from Lion TV contacted us when they heard about our collection, and we ended up sending down a big trunk full of original Victorian farm equipment and household items on loan to use in the series. I love things that have been well used and loved in past times, but our collection is growing so quickly we sadly have to sell a few things."
